MONTHLY Current Affairs Capsule for AIIMS MBBS ENTRANCE EXAM

- The Union cabinet approved the creation of a non-lapsable corpus fund for secondary and higher education.
- The corpus—Madhyamik and Uchchar Shiksha Kosh will have all the proceeds from the 1% cess the government collects under the 'secondary and higher education cess' which has been in place since 2007.
- The fund will be akin to the Prarambhik Shiksha Kosh.
- Union Cabinet has decided to extend the concept of creamy layer in OBC reservations to PSU & financial institutions.
It will ensure children of those serving in lower categories in PSUs & other institutions to get benefit of OBC reservation at par with children of people serving in lower categories in govt.
- Candidates whose parents hold constitutional posts or group A & B posts are excluded.
- Prime Minister Modi dedicated a hanging bridge built across the Chambal river at Kota to the nation.
- NITI Aayog launched Ease of Doing Business report based on an Enterprise Survey of 3,500 manufacturing firms across Indian states & UT's.
- Govt raises 'creamy layer' income cap o Govt has raised income limit defining creamy layer for OBC reservation by Rs 2 lakh p.a.
- National Sports Museum to be established o Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports is going to establish National Sports Museum at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi
- NITI Aayog CEO Amitabh Kant will launch the Mentor India Campaign in New Delhi.
- Triple talaq, the controversial Muslim divorce law that allows men to leave their wives immediately by uttering "talaq" thrice has been banned by Supreme Court
- Joint Entrance Examination for Indian Institute of Technology will go completely online from 2018.
- Reserve Bank of India will soon release Rs 50 denomination banknotes in the Mahatma Gandhi Series, having signature of Governor Urjit R. Patel.
- A Grant Agreement from the Global Environment Facility of the World Bank of \$24.64 million for "Ecosystem Service Improvement Project" was signed by the govt.
- Central govt has decided to grant exemption of 1 year from NEET system for students of govt colleges in Tamil Nadu
- Union Minister of State for HRD Mahendra Nath Pandey has launched an Indian National Anthem video in sign language.

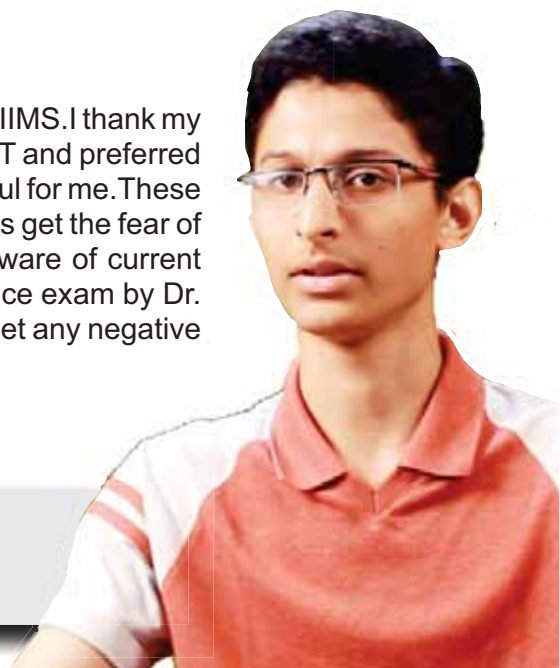
